

# CRITERIA REQUIRED TO SET A RSC SPEED RECORD

To be recognized as an RSC record holder for speed events the following criteria <u>MUST</u> be met:

- Score must be set at an event recognized and sanctioned by RSC. These events include: RSC Nationals, Provincials, Ontario Regionals, FISAC Worlds, World Jump Rope Championship, USA Jump Rope competitions and US Junior Olympics.
- There must be at least two judges capable of judging at a national level competition in their own country.
- All 3 judges MUST be members of a national jump rope organization
- There must be judges from at least two different teams (i.e. athletes cannot have 3 judges from their current team or alumni).
- Athletes must BEAT the current record, if the athlete ties the record, RSC will only recognize the athlete who originally set the record.
- If the record is set at an event that is not listed above (i.e. BC Records Day, ORSO Workshop) the event must be operated under similar conditions to a competition. The record must be set using a standard audio track and meet the judging criteria as listed above. Names of judges who counted the record MUST be noted so that it can be verified that the above requirements have been met.
