

RSC Post-Secondary Scholarship Criteria

(*Updated: January 16, 2023*)

The Rope Skipping Canada (RSC) Post-Secondary Scholarship is awarded annually at the RSC National Championships. The RSC Post-Secondary Scholarship is awarded to an applicant who is:

- An RSC full member in good standing
- A member of a recognized Provincial Sporting Organization (PSO) within RSC
 - This is determined by the number of PSO's holding a director position within the RSC Board of Directors
- Entering full-time post-secondary education at a College or University in the proceeding school year beginning in September of the same year following the National Championships

The successful applicant will receive \$1000.00 towards tuition reimbursement. All funds will be issued to the post-secondary institution, once proof of registration at the institution is received.

Application Process

Applications must be submitted annually by **April 1st**. Applications must include all required information as detailed below. It is the responsibility of the applicant to verify the application was received.

Please note: In evaluating the applications, no weight is given to competition results or rope skipping ability. Please do not include competition results or your personal scores in your application.

All members of the Award Committee will evaluate all scholarship applications. Shortlisted applicants will be invited to participate in a 5-10 minute telephone/skype interview to answer questions pertaining to their applications and contributions to rope skipping in Canada. Interview dates will be communicated to applicants who have been

shortlisted prior to April 30 annually. The committee will make their recommendation of the award winner to the RSC Board of Directors prior to the National Championships.

Rope Skipping Canada Scholarship Application: Required Documents

A composition (maximum 500 words) answering the following questions:	35%
a) What has rope skipping meant to me as a person?b) How am I enhancing the sport of rope skipping in my province?	
2. Transcripts or a complete record of secondary school grades. The committee requires an official transcript from all applicants who receive an interview. You will be provided with the necessary mailing address upon notification of being selected for an interview.	15%
3. Two letters of character reference (One, rope skipping related, one from outside of rope skipping.)	20%
4. A composition (maximum 300 words) describing your community involvement.	30%
5. Completed <i>Overview of Application</i> Form
